



## 2023 13U AA Competitive Team Commitments Agreement

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The NMBA Spring 13U AA Team will be competing against associations from Vancouver Island, primarily in Victoria. The team may also play in one or more additional tournaments, which may be elsewhere in BC. It is important that parents and players trying out for the NMBA Spring 13U AA Team understand the travel, financial, fundraising and volunteer commitments required to ensure a successful season. We request that you read this agreement and return the completed, signed form to NMBA prior to your tryout date.

### REQUIRED COMMITMENT FOR PARENTS AND PLAYERS

#### TRAVEL

There may be one or two trips off island to play tournaments that the team may enter. These will not be single day trips. They are held over the span of an entire weekend, so you will need to plan for this.

#### FUNDRAISING

Team fundraising initiatives will be developed to help offset the team's operation costs. This season NMBA will be matching fundraising efforts up to a certain dollar value. (Amount TBD)

### REQUIRED COMMITMENTS SPECIFIC TO PARENTS

#### VOLUNTEER DUTIES

Parent volunteers will be needed all season for things such as field prep and concession shifts when the team is hosting games. We will also be a need for a team manager to keep things organized and allow the coaches to focus on coaching the team.

### REQUIRED COMMITMENTS SPECIFIC TO PLAYERS

#### UMPIRING DUTIES

Players selected to the NMBA Spring 13U AA Team are encouraged to attend an umpire clinic. Players will be paid by the NMBA for the games they umpire and their umpire member fees will be reimbursed. More details will be provided for this commitment.
